

SCAVENGER HUNT

As a contestant, you've been given a sheet with pictures of 35 objects found in the Museum. Some objects may be large, some small, and some are printed on various displays. As you tour the Museum, look for these things.

Each object on your sheet will have a number in the lower left corner.

When you find one, use the other picture pages in your package to determine the museum area in which you found them. Each of these areas will have a letter. Write this letter underneath the found object, next to the found object's number.

There will often be more than one object in an area. Some areas look similar, so be sure you pick the right one.

When you have found as many as you can, write your name on the picture sheet and hand it to the contest judge for grading.

That's all there is to it. Easy, and lots of fun.

The contestant with the highest number of confirmed finds will be the winner. In the event of a tie, the winner will be determined by fair means, or in some cases, duplicate rewards will be given.

When you find an item, look at your area sheet, and get the letter & number of the area where you found it. Write that letter/number on this sheet, under each item you find.
